School meals update

Dear parent/carer,

As you will be aware, school meals service delivered by Tayside Contracts changed in August to enable schools to start to manage Covid19 health and safety protocols.

From then until 26 October, all meals had to be pre-ordered.

As of Monday 26 October, pupils will not require to pre-order their lunch.

A number of hot and cold options will be available and will be served on request. Meals will be served in disposable cartons and plastic forks and knives only will be used.

The only option will be for pupils to pay £2.25 for a full meal, consisting of a meal choice, a cake and a drink. There will be no other options available. Pupils will not be able to purchase individual items.

As in past, pupils can still pre-order a "street food" bagged meal to take away and they would do this by completing a form during registration.

Health and safety

Pupils will be able to take away their meal or sit in the dinner hall, space permitting, to eat it. We have managed to extend the seating available in the dinner hall.

As is the case at the moment, all pupils and staff must wear a face covering on entering the dinner hall and until they are seated and eating. Once finished eating, they should put on their mask again, before leaving their seat.

Pupils should continue to follow the one-way system already in place, at the entrance and exits and through the servery areas.

On leaving the table, pupils and staff must take individual responsibility for putting their own used cartons, plastic cutlery and packets into the bins provided.

For health and safety reasons, dinner hall staff cannot clear tables and touch other people's left food and empty packets.

No cash handling

Meals must be made with the pupil's NEC card only, with money pre-uploaded by parents/carers via Parent Pay or Pay Point.

If you have not already set up Parent Pay and wish to, please contact the school office and they will advise you what to do.

If your child does not have their NEC card, please ask them to come to the school office for information on how to get one.

NEC card applications can be made directly through Dundee City Council website www.dundee.gov.uk/national-entitlement-card. If you have any queries about this, please do not hesitate to contact the school.
